Rules of Exhibit

PLEASE READ CAREFULLY!!!

1. Entries are limited to two per artist and shall be 2 dimensional paintings, drawings or mixed media works. Artworks with protruding pieces will not be accepted. Entries must have been completed within the last 18months and are not to have been exhibited previously in Waipa District.
2. Entries must be **original**, not copied or created in a tutored situation. **No photography or computer images, enhanced or otherwise, will be eligible for entry.**
3. A completed Official Exhibit Label (see reverse) must be attached to the back of each piece entered. Copies of exhibit labels are acceptable. All forms must be completed in entirety. Exhibit labels are available from www.mtpirongia.org.nz.
4. The judges and Pirongia Te Aroaro o Kahu Restoration Society committee reserve the right to refuse entries.
5. **Fees.** An entry fee of \$15.00 for each piece will be payable to Pirongia Te Aroaro o Kahu Restoration Society, P.O. Box 34007, Pirongia, Waikato. Entry fees may be paid in cash, cheque or money order and are non-refundable.
6. All entries are to be for sale. A sales commission of 25% is payable to Pirongia Te Aroaro o Kahu Restoration Society Inc. Please price your work accordingly.
7. **Specifications. All entries must be framed and suitable for hanging, and no one side may measure more than 1 metre in length. D rings and wire for hanging must be firmly attached to the back. Wrapped canvasses with internal frames are acceptable, and are to be backed with foam/cardboard panels for protection.**
8. If shipping artwork, please courier it to Pirongia Te Aroaro o Kahu Restoration Society Inc, P.O. Box 34007, Pirongia, Waikato. Courierpost is the only courier that operates a pickup and delivery service in Pirongia, and this is the courier of choice for entries. All entries must arrive by 5-00pm Wednesday October 27th 2010. Alternatively you may deliver your entry to the **Chairperson of Pirongia Te Aroaro o Kahu Restoration Society, Clare St Pierre, 1106 Crozier Street, Pirongia.** Please contact her on (07) 8719 133 or stpierre@xtra.co.nz to arrange a suitable delivery time. The artist is required to pay cost of couriership both ways, and a return courier ticket is to be provided with each entry. If the painting is sold, the courier ticket will be returned to the artist by the organizers.
9. Artists are responsible for arranging their own insurance for both delivery and return (if required) when couriership.
10. Reasonable care will be taken at all times in handling entries, but entries will not be insured. Pirongia Te Aroaro o Kahu Restoration Society Inc shall not be responsible for loss of or damage to any artwork, no matter what the cause. By submitting artwork to this exhibition, each artist shall be deemed to have agreed to this condition.
11. A good quality photograph, preferable digital, is to be provided with each entry, plus an A4 size sheet of paper with a brief resume of the artist and their work. This will be used to compile a portfolio of entries to be available at the exhibition. 12. All entries are eligible and will be judged for awards. A selection process will apply and a panel of up to 5 judges will jury the awards. In the absence of a quality entry, no award will be made.
13. Art work will be accepted from Friday 22nd October 2010. **NO ENTRY WILL BE ACCEPTED AFTER 5-00pm on Wednesday 27th October, 2010.**
14. **IMPORTANT! NO ACCEPTED WORK MAY BE REMOVED FROM THE EXHIBIT UNTIL Sunday 7th November 2010 at 2-00pm.** It is proposed to exhibit award winners and merit entries for a limited time at Burchell Pavillion, Te Awamutu immediately following the

exhibition at Pirongia Memorial Hall. The artists involved will be advised of the arrangements, and any special requirements negotiated with them.

15. Signing the Entry Form will be taken as permission to publish the image for advertising and promotional purposes for Pirongia Te Aroaro o Kahu Restoration Society Inc.

16. Submission of entries in this competition automatically constitutes the entrant's acceptance of all competition rules. The judges' decision will be final and no correspondence will be entered into. Winners will be notified and announced at the opening ceremony.

Children's entries

1. Entries from children aged 15 years and younger are free, but will not be considered for the above art awards. Payment of the \$15-00 entry fee will qualify them for consideration with the adult entries for the Art Awards.
2. All other rules of exhibit, as above, apply to children's entries, except that:
 - a. Entries do not need to be framed, but must be mounted on card and in a condition suitable for wall display.
 - b. Entries do not need to be for sale.
 - c. No accepted work may be removed from the exhibit until 2-00pm on Saturday 7th November 2010.
